ORDER

In the circumstances reported by the Director of Mining & Geology in his letter read as 2nd paper above, Government are pleased to order that Kerala Land Information Mission (KLIM), State Project Office, Museum Bains Compound, Kowdiar P.O, Thiruvananthapuram -695003 is recognized as the agency of State Government for the preparation of Geo-referenced Cadastral Map to be submitted along with the Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining/Progressive Mine Closure Plan and Scheme of Prospecting, as per the instructions in the Circular 1st cited.

The roles, responsibilities and guidelines to stake holders in this regard are as follows:-

- As soon as Govt. Order granting Mining Lease/Prospecting Licence is received, the Department of Mining & Geology will send a copy of the approved plan and Govt. Order to KLIM with a copy to applicant.
- The applicant should erect concrete boundary pillars in the lease area and the same should be painted in yellow and should be serially numbered.
- Applicant should approach KLIM and remit the fee for the survey work and such other expenses and should render assistance for locating the site.
- KLIM should follow the guidelines mentioned in the Circular of Indian Bureau of Mines and accordingly carry out DGPS survey, prepare the plan showing boundary of lease superimpose these layers and test whether the all layers

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are matching. The softcopy and hardcopy of the said maps (with seal and signature) should be sent to Department of Mining & Geology and to applicant. The softcopy of the maps should be in standard format and the digitized maps should be in shape file.

- The applicant should use the maps received from KLIM for preparation of all statutory and as well as working plans of the mine.
- Since the lease deed is to be registered within six months of issue of Govt. Order, all such works should be completed well before six months.
